# CRAIGIE HILL GOLF CLUB

## ***General Information about Competitions***

It is not possible to cover all the disputes or queries which may arise concerning the Rules of Golf, but information covering all scenarios is held in the club office.

If in doubt about a ruling on any particular problem, or if you wish to make any changes affecting competitions etc, it is advisable to consult with the Match Secretary, Captain and/or fellow Directors.

By having this file of information available to members of the club it is hoped that it can act as a reference point for players unsure about what is expected of them in the various club competitions.

Both the Professional and the Match Secretary would be greatly aided in their work by members using these files to check on the running of club competitions. If they take time to acquaint themselves with these details it will save lots of time and possible misunderstanding.

The MATCH SECRETARY should organise all competitions by the display on the various notice boards of...

... and any match play competition sheets resulting from qualifying strokeplay competitions, or from a straightforward matchplay entry form. In matchplay competitions he is responsible for the results of ties being displayed by the due date and will take action to ensure ties are completed. The Match Secretary shall **not** be expecting to allow late entries to competitions or allow extensions to matchplay ties, except under exceptional circumstances.

(The Decision Is **His!**)

# CRAIGIE HILL GOLF CLUB

## All Saturday Competitions.

Entries should be made using the online booking system or by contacting the Professional. A draw will be made, normally on the Thursday prior to the competition date (but this may vary), and will be displayed on the website and in the locker room.

Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Professional **but competitors will not be allowed to change the time allocated to them in the draw.**

Under normal conditions competitors play in threes.

On the Saturday the Starter or Professional will collect the Entry Money, Sweep Money and the 2's Money (the sweep + 2's are optional). The entry money will be passed to the Club Office by the Professional. All sweep and 2's money will be retained by the Professional.

The Secretary or other nominated person is responsible for ensuring that the competition result list is handed to the Professional so that he can enter any cash winnings to members' accounts.

## Sweep Calculations

There are two categories:

|            |                  |
|------------|------------------|
| Division 1 | +4 – 12 handicap |
| Division 2 | 13 – 28 handicap |

When 'The Sweep' has been calculated for each section, it is divided into four prizes in

each section:

|                 |     |
|-----------------|-----|
| 1 <sup>st</sup> | 40% |
| 2 <sup>nd</sup> | 30% |
| 3 <sup>rd</sup> | 20% |
| 4 <sup>th</sup> | 10% |

In the event of a tie for 1st place, the money for 1st & 2nd places would be combined and divided between the winners, similarly for further ties at 2nd & 3rd places.

e.g. with **three** players tied for first, the money would be divided thus:

$$40\% + 30\% + 20\% / 3 = 30\% \text{ each}$$

A single player following this would get **10%** or...

...two players tied would share the 10% = **5% each**.

A check should have been made that the prize winners have in fact entered the sweep. If an error is made then players should consult amicably and honestly with the Secretary. The results are then entered on the appropriate sheet and then displayed on the notice board in the locker room.

Sharing sweep money is done as fairly as possible by the Secretary or other nominated person.

Players are responsible for checking that the correct score has been entered for each hole and the correct handicap used.

**Scores must be entered (including NRs) in the lounge computer and players should carefully check that they are entered under the correct name.**

**All unsigned cards are disqualified.**

# **CRAIGIE HILL GOLF CLUB**

## **Competition Winners**

The winner of a competition is generally the player with the lowest net score on the day.

However, there are tournaments with scratch and handicap winners:

e.g. Spring, Summer and Autumn meetings where it is possible for one person to be both winner and runner-up.

If this happens the rule is ONE PRIZE ONLY, the prize being the larger of the two prizes won. The decision lies with the Match Secretary.

# CRAIGIE HILL GOLF CLUB

## **Net / Scratch Score Ties.**

In the event of a net score tie in any section, the card with the best last 9 holes – *half the handicap being used in the calculation* – will be the winner.

If two cards or more have the same last 9 holes net total, then the last 6 holes are checked – *using one third of the handicap* – to decide the winner.

Should the scores remain tied then the last 3 holes will be checked – *using one sixth of the handicap* – to decide.

It may be that the last 2 holes and then the 18th hole need to be checked to decide.

One of the above will usually produce a result BUT, if it does not, then you have to go back to the last 12 holes – *using two thirds of the handicap* – to hopefully name a winner and generate a talking point.

In the case of scratch scores where the last 6 holes and last 3 holes are the same, the last 2 holes then the last holes are compared. If it is still a tie, then the last 12 holes are considered.

All the above calculations are automatically made by the computer scores system.

## Automatic Draw.

When there is a knockout competition following a qualifying round, the draw is made in the following manner:

## **Knock-out Competitions**

Competitors should pay close attention to the dates at the top of each round of the draw. Ties need to be played by the appointed dates.

While it is the responsibility of the challenger(s) (first named) to make contact to arrange a mutually convenient date, it is the responsibility of both competitors to ensure the tie is played. If there are difficulties, the challenger(s) should give his/ their opponents(s) 3 dates which must not be consecutive. No more than 2 dates may be given in one week, and only one date may be a Saturday or Sunday. For the purposes of competitions the week begins on a Monday.

Extensions to published closing dates will not normally be granted, although extenuating circumstances may be considered by the Match Secretary.

If no competitor's name is put forward, the Match Secretary will eliminate the challenger's name from the draw in the absence of good reason to the contrary.

All appeals must be directed to the Match Secretary.

## Summer League (March - October)

This competition is a singles all season competition taking two forms:

### Stroke Play and Eclectic Scores

Stroke Play (Best Eight): Players are allowed to enter three nett cards per week from the three days; Wednesday, Thursday & Sunday. There is no restriction on the number of cards a player may submit in the season.

A record will be kept and the winner shall be the player with the lowest nett score total from any eight cards. There will be numerous 'place' prizes.

Eclectic Score: From the same playing days and cards as the strokeplay the gross eclectic score of each player at every hole will be recorded.

The lowest 18-hole eclectic total Score shall be the winner. There will be numerous 'place' prizes.

As the total entry money is substantial, the Captain or Committee will decide the first prize value, the other prizes being relative.

Sweeps & 2's prizes will be calculated as per other competitions.

# CRAIGIE HILL GOLF CLUB

## **Winter League (October – March)**

The rules are as per the Summer League. Playing days are Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday, and Sunday.

The course will be played off Winter Tees and/or Greens at the discretion of the Committee.

The handicap allowance will be **FULL end of season handicap** of each player, or that decided by the Match Secretary.

**Handicaps will be reduced and/or increased as appropriate during the Winter League but will not affect summer handicaps.**

# **CRAIGIE HILL GOLF CLUB**

## **Checking Cards / Handicaps etc**

Any card not signed by either the player or marker will disqualify the player.

All additions should be checked and any amendments made without penalty.

Any player using a handicap higher than he is entitled to is disqualified.

Any players using a handicap lower than they are entitled to will play off the handicap used without further penalty.

**The handicap shown on the lounge computer must be used and any problems reported to the Secretary.**

## Etiquette

Slow play can destroy the pleasure of the game for other players, so please keep up with the game in front and don't keep the people behind you waiting. If you do fall back, call the players behind you through.

Two-ball matches should have priority over three and four-ball matches. A single player, in theory has no standing on the course, but discretion should be used when the course is quiet.

Always wait for the players ahead to get out of range before you strike your ball. If you hit a ball that looks as though it might land close to other people, please shout out the warning FORE!

If you are searching for a ball, wave the players behind you through as soon as it becomes apparent that you are holding them up.

Always leave a green as soon as you have finished putting, so that the players playing behind can play on to it.

Always try to be quiet and still when others are playing nearby or within line of sight.

Cards should be marked as soon as possible after leaving the green or on the next tee.

## Course Maintenance

Club members can do a lot to help our greenkeepers by repairing any damage they, and others, cause during play. By leaving each hole in a proper, playable condition, free of unnecessary hazards.

**The tee** is one place where golfers should not replace divots. There will be seeded sand in some tee boxes for the repair of divots on tees. Trolleys should be kept off tees. Players should attempt to do their practice swinging off the tees also to help preserve them.

Considerate golfers should replace **every divot** they take out of **a fairway** or section of **rough**. Failure to do so might result in golfers behind finding their tee shot in a divot hole later. No golfer enjoys playing from divots in fairways or the rough.

Golfers are requested to take a seed bag prior to commencing play, and to fill all divots as they progress through their round. Seed bags are available on a board located next to the first tee, and can be replaced, after play is completed, on a board located behind the eighteenth tee.

Players should always try to leave **a bunker** in better condition than they found it before they entered it.

It takes very little time to rake damage to bunker sand and then leave **the rake** in the bunker where it will cause little inconvenience to those playing behind. **Stones** from bunkers should be thrown off into bushes or long grass, not back in the bunker **after shot is played**.

### See Rule 23.1

On the green, the slightest blemish can make the difference between a birdie and a par.

The biggest crime is the failure to repair pitch marks. Not only do pitch marks alter the run of putts but, if not repaired, they create dead spots of grass. If every golfer repairs his own pitch mark on a green and at least two others, he would help greatly with course maintenance.

Never take your frustration out by damaging the green in any way. Leaning on your putter may also cause damage.

Never use your putter to retrieve the ball from the hole. You might damage the shape of the hole or the grass around the rim.

Take care not to drag your feet on greens. Damage around the hole will cause undue distress to the green and your fellow players.

Never pull or drive a trolley across a green. Always observe signs relating to trolleys.

No shot should be played from a 'wrong' green's surface.

Balls landing on a green other than target green must be lifted and dropped following Rule 25.3 except where there is a shared green (eg 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>)

## Guidelines and Rules Relating to the Entering of Competitions

**Direct Entry Competitions:** Entry sheets will be found in the Pro-shop. Try to print your name and handicap to make it easy to read. Please do this by date advised on sheets. Entry monies **must** be paid to the Professional prior to playing in the first round.

**Saturday Competitions/Medals:** Entries should be made via the website or by contacting the Professional on 01738 644622.

Late entries may be available at the discretion of the Professional **but players will not be permitted to change their playing time once the draw has been published.**

A printed copy of the official start sheet will be published on the Thursday afternoon, two days before the competition in the locker room and Professional's shop and on Craigie Hill's website at [www.craigiehill.co.uk](http://www.craigiehill.co.uk).

## CRAIGIE HILL GOLF CLUB

**Qualifying Competitions:** Some Saturday competitions qualify sixteen players for match-play rounds. If you do not wish to qualify, please write **NTQ** on score card. If you do qualify, your name will appear very soon on draw sheets on the notice board.

**Summer League:** Members wishing to play Summer League can reserve tee time times for themselves on the website or through the Professional. Entry or booking sheets will not be displayed on the notice board.

**Winter League:** Members wishing to play Winter League can do so on the website or with the Professional.

**Craigie Hill Opens:** Members wishing to play in one of the club's Opens will find entry sheets on the notice board well in advance of the competition dates.

**Invitation Competitions:** Members wishing to play in one of the club's invitation events will find entry sheets on the notice board well in advance of the competition dates. They should enter their own and the names/clubs of their guests on these sheets.

**Ties:** Times should be booked on the website or with the Professional.

### **Captain v Vice-Captain Opening Day**

The type of event may vary from year to year and will be publicised, in advance, on notice boards and the website.

# CRAIGIE HILL GOLF CLUB

## Texas Scrambles

Teams of Four compete in a four-ball stroke play event under normal 'Scramble' Rules.

Balls must be **PLACED** in close proximity to the chosen ball on the **fairway** but **DROPPED** in close proximity in the **rough**.

**Handicap Allowance may vary but is normally 1/8 of the combined.**

Each player usually contributes up to THREE tee shots but this may also vary.

# **CRAIGIE HILL GOLF CLUB**

## **The Order of Merit Award**

A Singles, season long, event open to all male members.

A record will be kept of scores from all singles medal events played from the start of the summer season. The winner shall be the player with the lowest total.

A leader-board will be maintained and displayed on both notice-boards and website.

# CRAIGIE HILL GOLF CLUB

## **The Norie Miller Trophy.**

A singles knockout competition open to all male members with a senior handicap.

There is no qualifying round for this competition.

The handicap Allowance is Full Difference.

Entry forms will be posted in the professional shop from 1<sup>st</sup> March each year.

Draw will be done the first Monday of April each year.

**Entry money must be paid to the Professional at the time of entering the competition.**

Competitors should pay close attention to the dates at the top of each round of the draw. Ties need to be played by the appointed dates.

Please refer to the **Knock-out Competition** guidelines for further information.

Extensions to published closing dates will not normally be granted, although extenuating circumstances may be considered by the Match Secretary.

If no competitor's name is put forward, the Match Secretary will eliminate the challenger's name from the draw in the absence of good reason to the contrary.

## **Foursomes Competition.**

A Pairs Knockout matchplay competition for all male members with a senior handicap.

There is no qualifying round.

The handicap allowance is HALF OF THE DIFFERENCE OF THE COMBINED HANDICAPS of the two sides.

Entry forms will be posted in the professional shop from 1<sup>st</sup> March each year.

Draw will be done the first Monday of April each year.

**Entry money must be paid to the Professional at the time of entering the competition.**

Competitors should pay close attention to the dates at the top of each round of the draw. Ties need to be played by the appointed dates.

Please refer to the **Knock-out Competition** guidelines for further information.

Extensions to published closing dates will not normally be granted, although extenuating circumstances may be considered by the Match Secretary.

Extensions to published closing dates will not normally be granted, although extenuating circumstances may be considered by the Match Secretary.

If no competitor's name is put forward, the Match Secretary will eliminate the challenger's name from the draw in the absence of good reason to the contrary.

## **Dr Clark Mixed Foursomes.**

A mixed pairs knockout matchplay competition open to all male and female members with a senior handicap.

There is no qualifying round for this competition.

The handicap allowance is HALF OF THE DIFFERENCE OF THE COMBINED HANDICAPS of the two sides.

**Entry money should be paid to the Professional before competing in round 1**

Competitors should pay close attention to the dates at the top of each round of the draw. Ties need to be played by the appointed dates.

Please refer to the **Knock-out Competition** guidelines for further information.

If no competitor's name is put forward, the Match Secretary will eliminate the challenger's name from the draw in the absence of good reason to the contrary.

## **Monthly Medals.**

There are TWO Gents monthly medals Section 1 (handicaps +4 to 12) and Section 2 (handicaps 13 to 28)

These are singles competitions open to all male members with a senior handicap.

Full handicap allowance will be taken.

**Monthly Medals are played throughout the summer and the winners from each month will play-off for the Section 1 and Section 2 Medals in October.**

## The Spring Meeting - Cameron Scratch & Handicap Medals

A singles stroke competition open to all male members with a senior handicap played over a single medal round.

The winners will be the best scratch score, and the best net score.

Full handicap allowance will be taken.

# **CRAIGIE HILL GOLF CLUB**

## **I R Wood Quaich**

A Fourball tournament with allowance of THREE-QUARTERS of INDIVIDUAL HANDICAP in the qualifying round.

Strokes are taken at the appropriate holes and the best net scores entered on the card.

The best SIXTEEN pairs will qualify for the matchplay stage. At this stage the handicap allowances are taken against the lowest handicap player who plays off scratch with the other players receiving THREE-QUARTERS of the difference.

Strokes taken by individual players according to stroke index.

# **CRAIGIE HILL GOLF CLUB**

## **Club Championship Match Play.**

A Singles stroke competition in the initial stage open to all male members with a senior handicap played over TWO qualifying rounds.

The top SIXTEEN scratch scores and the top SIXTEEN handicap scores from the two rounds will be drawn in two separate matchplay competitions. Scratch scores take precedence and the knock-out stage will be played over ONE WEEK.

Full handicap allowance is given where appropriate.

Qualifying rounds and matchplay competitions to be played off the white tees.

## **W R Farquharson Trophy.**

A Singles knockout competition open to all male members with a senior handicap.

The top sixteen net scores from the qualifying medal round will be drawn in match play after the medal round.

Full handicap is allowed in the qualifying round and in the match play.

Competitors should pay close attention to the dates at the top of each round of the draw. Ties need to be played by the appointed dates.

Please refer to the **Knock-out Competition** guidelines for further information.

Handicap allowance is THREE-QUARTERS of individual handicaps.

Strokes taken at appropriate holes and best net score entered on card.

## **PGA/Virgin Qualifier.**

A singles stroke competition open to all male members with a senior handicap, played over a single medal round.

This event is normally played near the beginning of season on same day as a monthly medal. The winner qualifies to play with the club professional at a regional event.

An fee is payable to enter for this competition in addition to the normal entry money.

Full handicap allowance will be taken.

# CRAIGIE HILL GOLF CLUB

## J. Bowie Trophy

The top sixteen net scores from the qualifying round will be drawn in match play in this singles knockout competition.

The format for knockout stage is medal match play i.e. better net score over eighteen holes wins.

Full handicap allowance will be taken in both qualifying and match play stages.

Competitors should pay close attention to the dates at the top of each round of the draw. Ties need to be played by the appointed dates.

Please refer to the **Knock-out Competition** guidelines for further information.

Extensions to published closing dates will not normally be granted, although extenuating circumstances may be considered by the Match Secretary.

If no competitor's name is put forward, the Match Secretary will eliminate the challenger's name from the draw in the absence of good reason to the contrary.

## **Hipsley Trophy.**

A singles stroke competition open to all male members with a senior handicap played over a single medal round.

Full handicap allowance will be taken.

## **The Summer Meeting – Sellar Scratch & Stavert Handicap Trophies**

A singles stroke competition open to all male members with a senior handicap.

The Scratch Sellar Trophy will be played over 18 holes.

The Handicap Stavert Trophy will be played over 18 holes.

The winners will have the lowest scratch and the lowest net scores.

Full handicap allowance will be taken.

## **McGill Trophy**

Played from **WHITE** tees.

A Stableford competition played over 5 rounds on various Sundays throughout the season open to all male members with a senior handicap.

The winner will be the player with the best three stableford scores

Full handicap allowance will be taken.

## **Sir Stanley Norie Miller Tray.**

A Singles Stroke Competition open to all male members with a senior handicap played over a single medal round.

Full handicap allowance will be taken.

# **CRAIGIE HILL GOLF CLUB**

## **Club Championship Stroke Play.**

A singles stroke competition open to all male members with a Gents handicap.

The event will normally be played on three consecutive Saturdays and may be combined with other competitions.

The winners will have the lowest combined scratch score and the lowest combined handicap score over the three rounds.
